Collingwood had three under 14s in the top 10 with **Anthony Crews**, with another two years in the age group, a little further back. **Ben White** continued his winning form to take out his fifth title of the winter –three with AV, today and last Tuesday’s state school’s championship. Adam Garganis put in another scorcher – he improves with every run. Meaghan Gaunt gained 20th. spot in a pretty strong field.
